The concept has two distinct TARGET GROUPS: The poets and the viewers. These have different desires who want to be met. Today s poets spend half their time writing and creating the art, and the rest of their time performing it. On big stages, with lavish outfits that correlates with their messages.

The viewers search for realness. A deeper meaning. Yet, they want to experience these words of wisdom while gazing at extraordinary outfits that speak volumes. The viewers support the poets on their journeys, to then ultimately follow their lead, on simple platforms like TikTok. To quote Taylor Swift "She ll know the way and then she ll say she got the map from me, I ll say I m happy for her then i ll cry myself to sleep."


THE TRENDS for this concept have emerged from a mix of fashion trends such as the willingness to upcycle materials, the need to ground thyself, layering langerie, slits in silky fabrics and pop culture medias current fixations and subcultures.

THE accent COLORS are based on a quote from each individual poet, which captures the feeling I experience they express in general and to which I also named the colors; Youth, Bliss, Love, Depth, Growth. Meanwhile, the mild base is drawn from trends such as romanticism and re-group, re-ground.

THE DETAILS consists of techniques used especially during the Romantic period, enhanced hips, Y2k styles, faux feathers in plenty and significant details for Harris Reed such as the dramatic boot cut, crinoline and circular head pieces.

THE MATERIALS are retrieved from deadstock and second-hand textiles. This, because of a sustainability point of view and to reconnect to the trend of upcycling. To work like this is also something that is familiar to Harris Reed as a brand.





Materials: Faux leather


Color ways: Lingerie (bone white), Depth (blue), Ink (black)

Details: Three top stiches on the back of the hand and one at the inner part of the sleeve

Description: Long sleeved glove in faux leather, available in three different color ways

Materials: Muslin and boning


Color ways: Love (red), Ink (black), Muslin (light yellow)

Details: Two buttons on the left side at the back for opening

Description: Crinoline, which widens laterally to emphasize the hip

Materials: Jersey, Denim


Color ways: Lingerie (bone white), Bliss (yellow), Depth (blue)

Details: Top stitches over the bust

Description: Jersey bralette with no straps, put on over the head. The denim bralette has a hidden zipper on the left side









Garter holder mini dress


Materials: Satin


Color ways: Powder (light pink), Depth (blue), Love (red)

Details: Strapless bodice, hidden zipper at the left side and top stitches front and back, from neckline down to the garter holder detailing

Description: Mini dress in silk, with details resembling garter holders









Materials: Satin, faux feathers and muslin

Color ways: Youth (pink) and lingerie (bone white), Muslin (light yellow) and bliss (yellow)

Details: Ends in deviating color/material, feather boa string to tie by the neckline and corset in the back, top stitches and darts by the bust

Description: Silk crop top with dramatic feather boa tie and cuts reminiscent of y2k as well as the romantic era









Enhanced hip mini skirt


Materials: Satin and muslin


Color ways: Youth (pink) and lingerie (bone white), Growth (green) and ink (black)

Details: Poofy drape outwards on the sides to enhance the hips and corset in back

Description: Mini skirt with voluminous hip drapes and corset fastening









Materials: Denim

Color ways: Mud (brown), Lingerie (bone white), Depth (blue)


Details: Corset in the back, top stitches, super high rise, signature boot cut, billowy hip enhancers which interlocks with the reinforced press folds


Description: Twisted take on the H.R. signature boot cut, with high waist and intriguing hip flares

Materials: Satin, faux feathers and chiffon

Color ways: Ink (brown) and growth (green), Powder (light pink) and love (red)


Details: Slits with chiffon inside, top stitches, upside down garter holders over the bust, deep plunge back, hidden zipper at the left side and faux feathers spilling over the strapless bodice

Description: Unique ankle long dress with feathers in focus. Chiffon-filled, u-shaped slits beginning at the thigh. Elements that connect to other pieces in the collection; strapless bodice and garter holder details

Materials: Satin, chiffon and faux feathers

Color ways: Muslin (light yellow) and bliss (yellow), Love (red)


Details: Top stitches, reinforced press folds hidden zipper on the right side, one H.R. signature boot cut leg, one chiffon leg with high slit, strapless bodice, feathers by the waist and asymmetric chiffon panel over left bust which ties in the back


Description: Pant suit with two different styles of legs

Boa & tulle dressing gown

Materials: Tulle and faux feathers

Color ways: Powder (light pink) and love (red), Mud (brown) and depth (blue), Growth (green)

Details: Hidden button by the collar, faux feather boa provided edges, asymmetric cuts, high neck, high slit, narrow armholes to resemble the y2k cut seen in the crop top from the collection

Description: Tulle dressing gown without sleeves, faux feather boas lining the edges to dramatize and romanticize
